Applicants need a minimum average of 70% with no individual mark below 60% in the five senior-level courses listed below (or equivalent). Visit **smu.ca/admissions** to see our competitive recognition for advanced studies, including IB, AP, A Level and CAPE.

## **Arts Majors**

English and four other academic courses

# **Commerce (Business) Majors**

English, mathematics\* and three other academic courses

English, pre-calculus\*, one academic science course and two other academic courses

Accepted courses: biology, physics, chemistry, computer programming

# **Diploma in Engineering**

English, pre-calculus, chemistry\*, one academic science course (physics recommended but not required) and one other academic course
